

**Schedule of Resolutions passed at The First Congress of the British Petanque Federation
held at Luton on 5th November, 2005.**

1. Policy on Protection of Junior and Vulnerable Members.

Resolved to adopt the policies and procedures developed by the BPA for the protection of Junior and Vulnerable Members. Resolved that during 2005 the BPF register with the Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) and that the BPF and member associations adopt a system of compulsory CRB checks via the BPF registration.

2. Equity Policy.

Resolved to adopt the Equity policies and procedures developed by the BPA.

3. Playing.

Resolved to hold the following competitions:

British Grand Prix Qualifying Series.
British Ladies Triples Championships.
British Junior Triples, and Doubles.

Resolved that the Great Britain representative teams for 2005 be arrived at as follows:

British Seniors and Ladies by qualification through a series of Grand Prix events. For the Seniors to be held in England, Scotland and Wales and for the Ladies in a suitable venue or venues.

The Ladies to follow a process as similar as possible to that of the Seniors so far as it is possible to achieve it within the current calendar constraints. The first qualifying team to represent Great Britain (GB Ladies 1) to play at the North Sea Tournament in 2005, and also to represent Great Britain at the European Ladies Championships in Denmark in 2005.

Juniors by selection from a squad of players determined by the GB Junior Team Managers. To assist in the selection process the BPF to hold British Junior Triples and Doubles Championships in 2005.
